"Killarumiyoc, known as 'the one who possesses the moonstone,' is a sacred temple dedicated to the goddess Mama Quilla. Located in the Sacred Valley of the Incas at 3,600 m.a.s.l. (11,811 ft.), this ceremonial space invites introspection, healing, and connection with feminine and lunar energy. Guided by the Q'eros, guardians of ancestral wisdom, you will experience a ceremony of gratitude and a profound encounter with your own heart."

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### **What is the ceremony in Killarumiyoq?**

In Killarumiyoq, the Q'eros perform a despacho ceremony, an ancestral offering that honors the Pachamama (Mother Earth), the Apus (mountain spirits), and lunar energy. This ritual uses coca leaves, flowers, colored wool, and sacred elements that represent gratitude, cleansing, and balance. It is a space to release emotions, find clarity, and strengthen your bond with the sacred.

### **Why do this ceremony with us?**

Because we work directly with authentic Q'ero Masters, heirs of the Inka cosmivision. Each experience is guided with respect, security, and love, ensuring a transformative encounter. We accompany you at all times with private transportation, a bilingual guide, and personalized assistance so your only task is to open your heart.





*"Killarumiyog is located just 1 hour and 30 minutes from Cusco, in a natural setting of mountains and agricultural fields. At 3,600 m.a.s.l. (11,811 ft), it offers a temperate climate during the day and a cool climate in the evenings. # DAY 1 ITINERARY

## Day 1 – Ascent and Ceremony

7:00 AM – Pickup in Cusco

Private transfer to the Sacred Valley, with a brief explanation of the Andean cosmivision and the meaning of Killarumiyoc.

8:30 AM – Arrival at the Sacred Site

Ceremonial welcome with coca leaves and ritual music.

9:00 AM – Initial Energy Cleansing

Purification with Andean plants (muña, rue, k'intu) guided by the Q'ero masters.

9:30 AM – Offering Ceremony (Despacho)

A collective gratitude and healing ritual in honor of the Pachamama and the lunar goddess.

11:30 AM – Meditation and Contemplation

Guided silent practice, connecting with the natural environment and the feminine energy of the Moon.

1:00 PM – Andean Snack

Tasting of local products: native potato, moraya (Andean freeze-dried potato), corn, and medicinal beverages.

2:00 PM – Personal Ceremonies (optional)

Opportunity to receive Chumpi Q'oa, an Andean massage, or vibrational healing with wind and sounds.

3:00 PM – Spiritual Discussion

Explanation of Q'ero symbols, textiles, and traditions. Ancestral music with pututos (conch shells) and songs of gratitude.

4:00 PM – Farewell and Energy Closing

Final invocation to Killa (the Moon), gratitude, and return to Cusco.

5:30 PM – Arrival in Cusco

End of service.


