What is Ñawpa Iglesia?

Ñawpa Iglesia is a pre-Christian ceremonial space where ancient Andean peoples maintained their rituals of connection with the Pachamama (Mother Earth), the Apus (mountain spirits), and the invisible guardians. It is considered a temple of memory and roots, where ancestors are honored and the spiritual memory of the visitor is activated.

Why do the ceremony with us?

With Memory Q'ero, you will experience the authentic Andean worldview guided by Paqos (shaman) Q'eros, direct descendants of the Inka tradition. Through rituals of offering, meditation, and ceremonial music, we accompany your healing process with respect, love, and ancestral wisdom.





Ñawpa Iglesia is located in a mountainous environment at over 3,200 m.a.s.l. (10,498 ft.), surrounded by rock formations that evoke the strength of the protective Apus. The climate is temperate during the day and cool in the afternoon, with potential for sudden temperature changes. Its strategic location makes it a powerful energetic point of connection with the spiritual past of the Andes.

Day 1 – Ascent and Ceremony

7:30 AM – Pickup from Cusco

- Departure in private transport to Ñawpa Iglesia (approx. 2h).
- The guide introduces the Andean worldview and the history of the site.

10:00 AM – Arrival and Permission Ritual

- Welcome from the Paqos Q'eros.
- Brief ceremony for energetic opening and requesting permission from the guardians.

11:00 AM – 1:00 PM – Group Connection Ceremony

- Offering ritual (Despacho) to the ancestors.
- Guided meditation and breathing practices.
- Releasing burdens and healing of family memory.

1:00 PM – 2:00 PM – Community Andean Lunch

- Meal with native products and spiritual dialogue with the Masters.

2:00 PM – Closing and Harmonization Ceremony


- Ritual of protection and gratitude.
- Ceremonial music and chants.

3:30 PM – Return to Cusco

- Final blessing and farewell.

6:30 PM – Arrival in Cusco

End of service.
