Temple of the Moon

Full day

The Temple of the Moon is located approximately 40 minutes from Cusco's Plaza de Armas, in an area far from the urban noise and surrounded by vibrant nature. This place, deeply sacred to the Q'ero Nation, is guarded by the protective Apus (mountain spirits) and enveloped in a special energy that favors contemplation, introspection, and spiritual connection. Thanks to its serenity and ancestral strength, the Temple of the Moon is an ideal space for traditional Andean ceremonies, offering a pure and silent environment, perfect for reconnecting with the Pachamama (Mother Earth) and the natural spirits.





Pachamama Ceremony – Gratitude, Healing, and Balance

The Pachamama Ceremony is an ancestral ritual of the Q'ero Nation, deeply rooted in the Andean cosmivision. It is an act of gratitude to life and to Mother Earth, who provides us with food, shelter, health, and energy every day.

An experience of transformation

Guided by a Q'ero master, the ceremony is an intimate, respectful, and deeply transformational experience, accompanied by a trilingual assistant (Quechua – Spanish – English) who facilitates understanding without altering the essence of the tradition. Every gesture, every element, and every word in this ceremony has a profound meaning, inherited from the wise Andean ancestors.

FULL DAY PROGRAM

Start and Transfer: Pick-up in Cusco and private transfer to the Temple of the Moon.

Connection Walk: Gentle 20-minute walk through the Andean landscape, in conscious silence, to prepare the spirit.

Ceremonial Preparation: Energy cleansing with sacred smoke and formation of the ceremonial circle with the Q'ero master.

Q'ero Wisdom: Conversation about the Q'ero worldview, the relationship with Pachamama and the Apus (mountain spirits), and the principle of Ayni (reciprocity).

Main Ceremony – Despacho to the Pachamama: A traditional offering (despacho) is prepared and buried with natural elements (coca leaves, sweets, flowers) to give thanks, ask for healing, and seek balance. Work is also done on chakra harmonization, and personal blessings may be received.

Closing: Gratitude and a moment of silence to integrate the experience.

Q'ero Textile Art: Brief display of traditional textile craftsmanship with sacred symbolism, available for purchase to support the community.

Return: Walk back to the transport and return to the hotel or agreed-upon location in Cusco.
